

# RAIN BARREL SALE AND REBATE PROGRAM

Rain barrels are used for the collection and storage of rainwater before it runs into the streets and gutters. Not only do they conserve water but they provide an economical way for League City residents to irrigate gardens and landscaping.

League City is now taking online orders on a first-come, first-served basis for 50-gallon "Ivy" rain barrels for the low price of \$65.

In addition, a limited number of League City Utility Billing residential customers can qualify for a \$25 rebate off their utility bill.

## TO ORDER:

1. Go to [www.leaguecity.com/rainbarrel](http://www.leaguecity.com/rainbarrel) and purchase your barrel using a credit or debit card. Orders must be placed and paid for by Sunday, May 24 at 11 p.m.
2. Pickup your rain barrel on Saturday, May 30 from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. at Hometown Heroes Park, 1001 E. League City Pkwy.

The barrels are 50-gallon capacity, mosquito resistant, locking child-proof lid, and include an overflow hose attachment. The barrels and all components are made in the USA out of 100% recycled materials. They are used for harvesting rain water, which helps protect rivers and streams from runoff pollution. They also help supplement the water supply by using rainwater to irrigate gardens and landscapes.
