## Canine Encounters COURSE #4065

**DATE:** December 8, 2021

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** Law enforcement encounters with aggressive dogs and other animals are generating more and more media attention and the use of force against animals is being questioned. Proper training will both prepare officers for these encounters and reduce criticism when force has to be used. The class will teach officers how to recognize canine aggression and interpret body language. Officers will learn defensive tactics and how to use less-lethal techniques in controlling canine encounters. This course is required for Intermediate and Advanced Certificates or within two years of licensure for those licensed after 04/01/2016 unless it was included in their BPOC.
